Plaintiff's motion to disqualify counsel is denied. Plaintiff's motion to amend is granted over objection. Motion to quash depositions by the two Representatives is denied insofar as matters under consideration for same do not concern ongoing specific responsibilities in the House, (nexus, as discussed in Lindley case) and they are not the subject of the litigation. The Lindley case in the Northern District, is also instructive in this distinction between Legislative immunity and legislative privilege, which is at issue here. Motion by Plaintiff's to dismiss counterclaims are denied. Counsel and parties should discuss, as requested by Court, prospects of using a mediator and/or whether a new scheduling order will be needed as a result of today's rulings.
