ORDER FOR PRODUCTION OF WITNESS TRANSCRIPTS WITHOUT REDACTION


NOW on this 5 day of November, 2012, this matter comes on for hearing regarding the prior application of Windstream Corporation for production of Grand Jury Transcripts for use as provided by law upon Indictments issued by the grand jury. The Court, having now been advised by the grand jury's legal advisors that there is no cause for conducting a relevancy review of the several transcripts previously *Ordered* produced for the Defendant, now **FINDS** that said transcripts should be produced in their entirety without redaction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Court Reporter for the Oklahoma Multicounty Grand Jury shall prepare a official shorthand reporters' transcripts for Defendant, in their entirety and without redaction, for the grand jury witnesses previously identified and *Ordered*.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that upon completion of said transcript, the same is to be made available to John D. Russell, Esq., Warren Bickford, Esq., and Sofia R. Nagda, Esq., attorneys for Defendant, upon payment of the expense for such transcription, and that true, full and complete copies of all relevant exhibits provided to the grand jury also be provided to counsel for Defendant. **Use of said transcripts by the Defendant shall be as provided by 22 O.S. § 340(B).**
