Dear Board Members-

I was under the impression that after Stephanie and I had met with Dr. Sisney Monday, June 16th, that he was going to send an email apology to Mr. Rampey. Dr. Sisney actually came up with the idea. I had sent a follow up email to Dr. Sisney and copied Stephanie on June 16th at 3:30 in agreement of an apology email to Mr. Rampey. Since this did not happen and Mr. Rampey has met with all the Board and has not heard anything from us in over a week, getting a letter from him does not surprise me too much.

As far as meeting regarding this letter, waiting till the July 14th Board meeting may be a bit of wait- allowing this to escalate even further. I would prefer to address at earliest to resolve.
