

Suspended BA superintendent says he won't request hearing

Suspended Broken Arrow Superintendent Jim Sisney announced Friday that he would not request a due process hearing, but may instead file a wrongful termination and breach of contract lawsuit against the Broken Arrow School Board.

The school board voted 3-2 Oct. 6 during a special meeting to immediately suspend Sisney and send him written notification of the reasons for his possible termination.

Gary Richardson, Sisney's attorney, said during a news conference Friday that in view of the stacked school board, Sisney would not seek a hearing.

"He'll take his cause to a court of law before a judge and 12 unbiased jurors," Richardson said.
